Nomination and Application Process

Student nomination must reach CIELS by: Fall (First) Semester / Full year: 20th May 2025

20" May 2025

Spring (Second) Semester: 15th October 2025

Application for nominated students must reach CIELS by:

Autumn (First) Semester / Full year:

20th June 2025

Spring (Second) Semester:

30th November 2025

To finalize the application nominated students will be asked to:

- complete their Learning Agreement.

At CIELS we use the OLA (Online Learning Agreement) through the Erasmus Dashboard. Of course, if the home university adopts a different LA we can accept it.

Language requirements

Students must have a minimum of 75% attendance for each course.

Student and Staff Support

The International Relations Office is open from Monday to Friday (9:00-12:30, 13:30-15:30) in order to help incoming students.

CIELS also provides an Incoming Tutor to support students with their needs.

Canteen and Cafeteria

At CIELS we have a cafeteria and a canteen. Students will need a QR code to access and the information will be provided by the International Relations Office before your arrival.

Student Accommodation

CIELS does not offer accommodations for incoming students. However, information and assistance will be provided by the International Relations Office.

Fiscal Code (CODICE FISCALE)

The Fiscal Code (*Codice Fiscale*) is a code made up of letters and numbers on the basis of your first name, family name, date and place of birth and it is used by the Public Administration to identify the citizens living in Italy. All those living in Italy need and have their own, otherwise it will not be possible to rent a flat. The International Relations Office will send students the Instructions to obtain the Fiscal Code.

Health

Students must have their European Health Insurance Card (EHIC), issued by their country's Health Service, or health insurance, before coming to Italy. For urgent need of hospital care, student must go directly to the nearest hospital (*Pronto Soccorso*), with their EHIC.



Local Transportation



Students can reach CIELS by bus n. 3, the bus stop is "Bembo 63".

A ticket costs about €1.70.

The Local Transportation Office Busitalia offers monthly and annual transportation passes with special fares for those under 26 years of age.
